Celebrant Alleluia. Christ is risen.
People **The Lord is risen indeed. Alleluia.**

FOR THE DAY OF PENTECOST, *and*
OCCASIONS OF CONFIRMATION *and* ORDINATION

Celebrant The Lord will pour out his Spirit upon all flesh;
People **And your sons and daughters shall prophesy.**
Celebrant Your old men shall dream dreams,
People **And your young men shall see visions.**
Celebrant Ye shall know that the Lord is in the midst of his people,
People **And that he is the Lord, and none else.**
Celebrant And it shall come to pass;
People **That whosoever shall call on the name of the Lord
shall be delivered.**
