SEASONAL GREETINGS

The opening Acclamation may be replaced by a greeting appropriate to the season or the occasion, such as the following

FOR ADVENT

Celebrant Surely the Lord cometh soon.

People **Amen. Come Lord Jesus!**

FOR CHRISTMASTIDE *and* THE FEAST OF THE PRESENTATION OF CHRIST

Celebrant For unto us a child is born,

People **Unto us a son is given.**

FROM THE FEAST OF THE EPIPHANY *to* THE END OF THE EPIPHANY SEASON

Celebrant I will make thee as a light for the nations,

People **That my salvation may reach unto the end
of the earth.**

FROM ASH WEDNESDAY *to* THE EVE OF PALM SUNDAY
or PENITENTIAL OCCASIONS

Celebrant Bless the Lord who forgiveth all our sins.
People **His mercy endureth for ever.**

FOR HOLY WEEK

Celebrant Blessed be our God.
People **Now and for ever. Amen.**

FROM EASTER DAY *until* THE EVE OF PENTECOST

Celebrant Alleluia! Christ is risen!
People **The Lord is risen indeed! Alleluia!**

FOR THE DAY OF PENTECOST, *and*
OCCASIONS OF CONFIRMATION *and* ORDINATION

Celebrant The Lord will pour out his Spirit upon all flesh,
People **And your sons and daughters shall prophesy.**
Celebrant Your old men shall dream dreams,
People **And your young men shall see visions.**
Celebrant Ye shall know that the Lord is in the midst of his people,
People **That he is the Lord and there is none else.**
Celebrant And it shall come to pass
People **That everyone who calls on the Name of the Lord
shall be saved.**
